RESOLUTION DECLARING A 1964 MOBILE MK FORKLIFT
SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal of surplus equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the 1964 Mobile MK Forklift, Unit 978, S/N# 25600633, has been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned Mobile MK Forklift is hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the equipment in the best interest of Sarpy County.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 23rd day of April, 2013.



Re: Surplus Of 1964 Mobile ML Forklift


Sarpy County Public Works is requesting that a 1964 Mobile MK Forklift be surplused. Per Sarpy County Resolution "Approving Vehicle Acquisition & Disbursement Policy", January 13, 1998, attached is Fleet Services' recommendation for disposal of the equipment.

The 1964 Mobile MK Forklift, Unit 978, S/N# 25600633, was obtained over 25 years ago from the City of Lincoln's surplus. It has not been used for a number of years. This equipment would need major engine and brake repairs. It is not cost effective to repair, as it would cost far more than the value of the equipment.

It is recommended that the attached Resolution, declaring the 1964 Mobile MK Forklift surplus property, be signed.
