WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal; and,

WHEREAS, the following vehicles have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

1. Unit 124 - 1994 Chevy Truck - VIN: 1GBKC34FXRJ109075, Mileage: 122,238 - Public Works.
2. Unit: 152 - 1995 Ford Truck - VIN: 1FTEX14H95KB55855, Mileage: 164,866 - Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned vehicles are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the vehicles in the best interest of Sarpy County.
