

**BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STOP SIGN CHANGE ON 132ND STREET AND CAPEHART ROAD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 23-104(6) (Reissue 2012), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 23-103 (Reissue 2012), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 39-1402 (Reissue 2008), general supervision and control of the public roads of each county is vested in the county board.

WHEREAS, due to the traffic volumes split and the paving improvements to 132nd street, the Sarpy County Public Works Department has created a location plan to change the intersection from being stop controlled northbound and southbound to stop controlled eastbound and westbound and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Engineer recommends changing the intersection from being stop controlled northbound and southbound to stop controlled eastbound and westbound on the location plan attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, placing the signs as indicated is in the best interests of the citizens of Sarpy County, Nebraska.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the recommendation of the County Engineer to change the intersection from being stop controlled northbound and southbound to stop controlled eastbound and westbound as indicated on the location plan is hereby accepted and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sarpy County shall take such steps to post appropriate signs according to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices at the locations as indicated on the location plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.



SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Stop Sign Change on 132nd Street and Capehart Road

I recommend approval of the resolution to shift the stop sign configuration from the north and south legs being stop controlled to the east and west legs being stopped controlled at the intersection of 132nd Street and Capehart Road as follows:

- a) Sarpy County Public Works Department will be placing these regulatory signs in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- b) Sarpy County Public Works Department will be notifying the Sarpy County Sheriff's Department of the change that will take place.
- c) A temporary 4-Way (All-Way) stop will be configured at the intersection to accustom drivers to stopping on the west and east legs of the intersection.

The Sarpy County Engineer's Office has reviewed the intersection in question. The recent paving improvements coupled with the most current traffic counts have designated the north/south (132nd Street) roadway to be the major roadway; therefore the signage should be changed.
