WHEREAS, the County Engineer has prepared his recommendations concerning said vacation; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §39-1722, *et seq.*, (Reissue 2008), the County Board of Commissioners is authorized to vacate or abandon certain roadways or parts thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SARPY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §39-1722, *et seq.*, (Reissue 2008) a public hearing will be held on the 24th day of September, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. in the Board Room of the Sarpy County Courthouse, Papillion, Nebraska, to receive public comment regarding the vacation of the following:

That portion of Cornhusker Road from the easterly right of way line of 132nd Street, easterly to a point 147.5 feet west of the SE 1/4 Corner of the SW ¼ of Section 19, T14N, R12E of the 6th P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska as more particularly described on Attachment A.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is directed to publish notice of said public hearing as required by law.

Re: Vacation of Cornhusker Road, east from 132nd

I recommend approval of the vacation of Cornhusker Road as submitted. The Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District requests the vacation of Cornhusker Road from 132nd Street to a point approximately 2400 feet east of 132nd Street in conjunction with their WP-5 flood control project for the West Papillion Basin. The District is the land owner on both sides of the proposed vacation.

Any and all utilities will be removed or relocated for this project.

This roadway is located within the City jurisdiction of the City of Papillion. Papillion Public Works and City Engineer have no objections and we are cleared to vacate the street.

There will be no cost to the PMRNRD for acquiring the vacated property.


VACATION OF CORNHUSKER ROAD, EAST OF 132ND STREET

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

That part of Cornhusker Road in the Southwest Quarter of Section 19, T14N, R12E and the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, T14N, R12E of the 6th P.M., Sarpy County, Nebraska, being 33 feet on each side of the centerline described as follows: beginning at a point 50.0 feet east of the Southwest Corner of said Section 19; thence easterly along said centerline and along the southerly line of said Section 19, a distance of 2414.8 feet to a point 33 feet normally distant southerly from the intersection of the easterly line of a parcel of land owned by Papio-Missouri River National Resources District (recorded as Inst. No. 2010-0018) and the northerly 33 foot right-of-way line of said Cornhusker Road, said point being the terminus of said centerline.
