RESOLUTION DECLARING LIGHT BAR SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-104 (Reissue 2012), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-103 (Reissue 2012), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board;

WHEREAS, the County is in possession of an LED interior lighting system (hereinafter "light bar"), Serial # SE399 (VALUE), made for the windshield design of the Ford Crown Victoria – a vehicle that is no longer in production;

WHEREAS, the light bar is obsolete and/or not usable by the County; and

WHEREAS, the County finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Sarpy County to donate the light bar to the Bellevue Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SARPY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned light bar is hereby declared to be surplus property pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 23-3115 (Reissue 2012) and the Purchasing Department is hereby authorized to dispose of the light bar by donating it to the Bellevue Police Department.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 10th day of September, 2013.


