WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office has been awarded the mini-grant reimbursement funding; and,



WHEREAS, Sheriff Jeff Davis signed the award and returned it to the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety on October 11, 2013; and,

1. Baseline Information

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is applying for the November 25-December 1, 2013 "Click it or Ticket" Mobilization grant, to continue aggressive enforcement of motorist's violating the State of Nebraska's seat belt law and child restraint law. Sarpy County continues to experience problems with motorists not using seat belts or child restraints, and recent accidents in Sarpy County revealed that some of our injured motorists were not using seat belts at the time of their motor vehicle accidents.

2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is planning a "Click It or Ticket" program of both survey work and aggressive enforcement patrols with zero tolerance on seat belt and child restraint violations. With strict enforcement of seat belt and child restraint violations, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office hopes to reduce serious motor vehicle accidents and heighten the public's awareness of safety when driving on the roadways of Sarpy County Nebraska.

3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will target areas throughout our county at different periods of the day. We will be conducting all activity beginning November 25 and ending December 1, 2013 for "Click It or Ticket". As always, we will be cooperating with surrounding agencies in the Metro Omaha area for strict enforcement of all law violations, specifically over the Memorial Day Holiday weekend.

4. Selective Overtime Budget

Two (2) deputies for four (4) hours on seven (7) days: November 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and December 1, 2013:

Two (2) deputies overtime for four (4) hours five (5) regular days = \$1,859.16 + Social Security \$142.23 + Retirement \$162.68 = \$2,164.07

Two (2) deputies holiday overtime for four (4) hours on Thanksgiving Day and the Day after Thanksgiving = \$1,239.44 + Social Security \$94.82 + Retirement \$108.45 = \$1,442.71

Total \$3,606.78

5. Impact Evaluation

Through the use of this "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant", the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is expecting to reduce the number of seat belt and child restraint violators that operate on the roadways of Sarpy County. We will also be encouraging the use of seat belts and child restraints in an attempt to reduce serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents within our county.
