ROAD EQUIPMENT ATTACHMENTS SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 2012), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2012), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works road equipment attachments, listed in Exhibit A attached, have been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned equipment attachments are hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the equipment attachments in the best interest of Sarpy County.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 8th day of April, 2014.




1950 3PH GRINDER NON OSHA APPROVED GAURDS



1984 BAKER-FLINK PLOW NO TAG NUMBERS












