NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SARPY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT the Hi-Prox 6040, S/N 16540 x-ray machine is hereby declared to be surplus property and the Purchasing Department is authorized to dispose of the x-ray machine in the best interest of Sarpy County.



Please find below the description of an old x-ray machine that Sarpy County Sheriff's Court Services is requesting permission to surplus.

Hi-Prox 6040, Model 2416 MB-8, S/N 16540 x-ray machine was donated to the Sheriff's Department by the National Park Service in late 2007.

The manufacturer no longer supports any maintenance for the unit. X-ray machines require an annual certification for State compliance.

Disposal of this unit will follow any and all environment safety requirements.
