WHEREAS, Sarpy County was awarded funding through the "You Drink and Drive, You Lose" grant; and,


WHEREAS, Sarpy County Sheriff Jeff Davis signed the award for the "You Drink and Drive, You Lose" grant; and,


WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports funding for the grant referenced in the attached memo; and;

Re: Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant Award for the National "You Drink and Drive, You Lose" campaign.

On August 19, 2014, the County Board will be asked to ratify the submission and award for the Selective Alcohol Overtime Enforcement grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO). The grant was applied for and submitted by the SCSO.

The grant awards up to \$13,324.96 in overtime reimbursement to the SCSO from August 15 – September 1, 2014. The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will aggressively pursue drivers who are impaired, targeting specific roadways where serious injury and fatality accidents have occurred. The objective will be to saturate main roadways with extra deputies for the purpose of detecting alcohol impaired drivers.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this Mini-Grant Contract is to provide funding assistance to law enforcement agencies for selective overtime enforcement in the emphasis area of: (Check One) Alcohol [X], Speed [], or General Traffic []. The funding assistance will provide reimbursement for overtime salaries and/or mileage. Regular traffic enforcement activities must remain at the current level and all activities funded by this mini-grant must be above and beyond the current level of enforcement activity. Please complete items 1 - 5 below using the definitions are on the reverse side, and submit a copy of your department's current seat belt policy and drug-free workplace policy.

- 1. Baseline Information: To participate in the National You Drink & Drive. You Lose. Crackdown August 15-September 1, 2014.
2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective: To decrease alcohol-impaired fatal, A and B injury crashes by 7% from the 2008-2012 calendar base year average of 620 to 577 by December 31, 2014.

Within sixty (60) days from the conclusion of the activity the reimbursement request must be submitted. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements will not be honored.

This Mini-Grant Contract is financed on a reimbursement basis. The applicant must 1) receive approval of the Mini-Grant Contract from the NOHS; 2) incur the expenses (pay the bills); 3) request reimbursement for the amount awarded on a "Mini-Grant Contract Claim for Reimbursement (CR) located on the NOHS website at www.transportation.nebraska.gov/nohs/contract.html; and 4) complete the CR and attach the required supporting documentation as prescribed below.

Ref: "You Drink & Drive. You Lose" Crackdown

1. Baseline Information

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is applying for a "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant" for the August 15-September 1, 2014 "You Drink & Drive, You Lose" Crackdown. The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office would like to participate in this crackdown as. During this holiday time, our community has experienced several serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents in previous years. These serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents have occurred both during the daytime, as well as night, and have mainly occurred on the major roadways in Sarpy County. Unfortunately, many of the night time serious motor vehicle accidents involved intoxicated drivers.

2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office believes that with the assistance from your office, we can put more deputies on the roadways during this holiday season and significantly reduce the number of serious and fatal motor vehicle accidents, by targeting speeders, traffic violators, and most importantly, intoxicated drivers. By targeting the roadways and traffic violation, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office believes we can significantly reduce the number of serious motor vehicle accidents in Sarpy County Nebraska.

3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity

The Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will target the main roadways in Sarpy County to include Highway 75, Highway 370, Highway 50, and Highway 6/31. We will have four (2) extra deputies patrol the evening and late night hours in order to cover the hours when liquor establishments are closing. Our deputies will focus their enforcement actions on general traffic violations such as speeding, and other infractions, with a main focus on removing intoxicated

drivers off of the roadways of Sarpy County Nebraska. We will also have one (1) extra jail deputy, and one (1) extra booking clerk to handle the increase in persons arrested and booked into the Sarpy County Jail.

4. Selective Overtime Budget

Three (3) deputies, and one booking clerk for six hours on each of the ten (10) days: August 15, 16, 17, 22, 23, 24, 29, 30, 31, and September 1, 2014.

Three (3) deputies overtime for six (6) hours on nine (9) regular days = \$7,833.83 + Social Security \$599.29 + Retirement \$685.46 = \$9,118.58

Three (3) deputies holiday overtime for six (6) hours on Labor Day = \$1,450.71 + Social Security \$110.98 + Retirement \$126.94 = \$1,688.63

One (1) booking Clerk overtime for six (6) hours on nine (9) regular days = \$1856.95 + Social Security \$142.06 + Retirement \$125.34 = \$2,124.35

One (1) booking clerk holiday overtime for six (6) hours on Labor Day = \$343.88 + Social Security \$26.31 + Retirement \$23.21 = \$393.40

Grand Total = \$11,485.37 + \$878.64 (SSN) + \$960.95 (RET) = \$13,324.96

5. Impact Evaluation

Through the use of this "Selective Overtime Enforcement Mini-Grant", the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office is expecting to reduce the number of alcohol/drug related impaired driver's that operate on the roadways of Sarpy County. As always, our goal is to reduce the number of serious and fatal accidents that impaired driver's cause on our roadways.
