WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 2012), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Juvenile Justice Center requires the maintenance services for the surveillance system, and;

WHEREAS, Electronic Solutions Inc. has the experience and qualifications required by Sarpy County to perform such services.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that:



Surveillance Equipment Service Contract: **SCJJC15**

We, ESI, (also as; Contractor and or consultant) submit this Maintenance Contract to service the following equipment at the above stated address:

Surveillance Cameras, All existing CCTV cameras and accessories. Power supplies and wiring related to the cameras
Control and Data Wires related to cameras. Digital Video Recorders, Video Cassette Recorders, Monitors, multiplexers and matrix switchers.

Our fees are based on a 24 HOUR RESPONSE TIME to service calls from time of our knowledge of problem.
For PTZ service, extra time will need to be allowed for scheduling delivery of boom lift, depending on weather conditions.

We will service equipment from 8:00am – 5:00pm, Monday – Friday. For after hour and/ or weekend service work we will require a \$ 75.00 flat fee, per occurrence. The time we are onsite after hours/ weekend we will apply towards the contract. We will send invoices to the facility.

We have staff on call 24hours a day. Our office phone number is forwarded to the on-call tech cell phone.
Contract includes labor for repair/ maintenance of camera system including materials and parts.
Equipment that cannot be repaired on-site, we will order overnight shipment equipment for replacement.
Additional billing will be strictly NET 30 days.
References and business liability insurance certificate, available upon request.

A onetime check will be accepted at beginning of contract term for the full amount.

Renewal – This Agreement shall be for a term of 5 years; beginning on January 1, 2015 and expiring in December 31, 2019 unless terminated by either party by giving the other written notice of termination at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of any one year period.



Termination – Either party may terminate the Contract with ninety (90) days written notice to the other party.

Residency Verification - The Consultant agrees to comply with the residency verification requirements of Neb. Rev. Stat. §4-108 through §4-114. The Consultant is required and hereby agrees to use a federal immigration verification system to determine the work eligibility status of new employees physically performing services within the State of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program authorized by the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee.

Severability -The Scope of Services shall be interpreted, construed and enforced under the laws of the State of Nebraska. It is understood and agreed by the County and Consultant hereto that if any part, term, condition, or provision of this Statement of Work is held to be illegal or in conflict with any law of the State of Nebraska or of the United States, the validity of the remaining parts, terms, conditions, or provisions shall not be affected, and the rights and obligations of the County and Consultant shall be construed and enforced as if the Scope of Services did not contain the particular part, term, condition, or provision held to be invalid.
