WHEREAS, the grant application was signed by the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office; and


WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports submission of the grant referenced in the attached memo; and;



On February 11, 2014 the County Board will be asked to ratify the award for the Preliminary Breath Tester (PBG) Mini- Grant with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS) and the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office (SCSO).


