WHEREAS, the grant referenced in the attached memo was available to the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office; and,


WHEREAS, the grant application was submitted by the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office; and,

On March 18, 2014 the County Board will be asked to ratify the application for the Project Extra Mile Mini-Grant through the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety (NOHS). The grant was applied for and submitted by the SCSO.

The grant requests up to \$1,837.88 in overtime reimbursement to the SCSO for the Project Extra Mile campaign. Through Project Extra Mile, the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office will conduct compliance checks at local establishments and convenience stores to ensure they are not selling alcohol to minors. In addition, MIP enforcement will also be increased. The goal is to reduce the sale of alcohol to minors and reduce driving under the influence of alcohol by minors.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this Mini-Grant Contract is to provide funding assistance to law enforcement agencies for selective overtime enforcement in the emphasis area of: (Check One) Alcohol , Speed , or General Traffic . The funding assistance will provide reimbursement for overtime salaries and/or mileage. Regular traffic enforcement activities must remain at the current level and all activities funded by this mini-grant must be above and beyond the current level of enforcement activity.

Please complete items 1 - 5 below using the definitions are on the reverse side, and submit a copy of your department's current seat belt policy and drug-free workplace policy.

1. Baseline Information:

Project X Mile enforcement effort to conduct compliance checks for establishments selling alcohol to minors. Also selective MIP enforcement. Compliance check dates April 17 and May 8, 2014. Selective dates are April 18, and May 9, 2014.

2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective:

To reduce the sale of alcohol to minors and to reduce alcohol consumption and to reduce driving under the influence of alcohol by minors.

3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity:

Officers will send an informant to an establishment and attempt to purchase alcohol. If sale is made to minor the clerk will be cited for the offense. Additionally, selective MIP enforcement will be conducted.

4. Selective Overtime Enforcement Budget:

8 deputies @ \$56.39 x 28 hours = \$1,578.926. Social Security tax = \$120.79. Retirement = \$138.16. Total budget = 1,837.88

5. Impact Evaluation:


The compliance rate this enforcement will be compared to previous compliance rates for the same type of efforts.

Within sixty (60) days from the conclusion of the activity the reimbursement request must be submitted. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements will not be honored.

This Mini-Grant Contract is financed on a reimbursement basis. The applicant must 1) receive approval of the Mini-Grant Contract from the NOHS; 2) incur the expenses (pay the bills); 3) request reimbursement for the amount awarded on a "Mini-Grant Contract Claim for Reimbursement (CR) located on the NOHS website at www.transportation.nebraska.gov/nohs/contract.html; and 4) complete the CR and attach the required supporting documentation as prescribed below.

- a) Copies of the pre- and post publicity announcing the overtime enforcement activity.
- b) Nebraska - Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity Summary (provided with award letter).
- c) Total miles driven (if mileage reimbursement is requested). Selective Overtime Enforcement Mileage Log must be attached.
- d) Provide the name, number of hours worked, regular and overtime hourly rates, and SFST certificate (alcohol only) for each officer.
- e) Provide the amount paid to each officer and payroll documents to substantiate each expenditure.

Acceptance of Conditions: The Mini-Grant Contract Award recipient agrees to comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules and regulations, and certification and assurances located in Attachment A of the Grant Contract Proposal Guide and Policies and Procedures. The Guide can be found on the NOHS website at www.transportation.nebraska.gov/nohs/contract.html. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in termination of this Grant Contract Award. All Awards are subject to availability of Federal Funding.
