WHEREAS, the grant application must be submitted to the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality.


WHEREAS, Sarpy County is committed to and supports the grant application for the Storm Water Management Plan Program; and;

## RE: 2013 Stormwater Management Plan Grant Program – Application

Dear Lisa:

The Nebraska Legislature passed LB1226 in 2006 (Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-2,129), which established the Stormwater Management Plan Program. This grant program has provided seven years of funding to cities and counties with Stormwater permits to implement their local Stormwater Management Plans (SWMPs). An eighth year of grant funding is now available for distribution to these same cities and counties. Cities and counties must work directly from their approved NPDES MS4 Stormwater Management Plan when making decisions on how to spend the grant and matching funds.

**Sarpy County**, permit #NER210007, is entitled to at least **\$113,169** and no more than **\$1,459,997** of these funds. Applicants located within urbanized areas will receive their share of funding from 80% of the total amount available and those in non-urbanized areas will receive their share from 20% of the total. Funding within each category will be distributed amongst the applicants based on their population. If every eligible applicant in your category requests funding, you will receive the minimum amount – if fewer apply, you will receive a larger share.

**If interested in obtaining funding, a signed copy of the enclosed one-page application must be mailed (or emailed) to me by Friday, September 20th.** Be sure to make a choice in the “Check Desired Funding” box. If an amount less than the above maximum award is desired, enter the amount in the “Other” box. Please let me know if you’d like an electronic copy of the application.

Enclosed are the 2013 Stormwater Management Plan Program timeline, a list of reports due to NDEQ, and the one page grant application. **Please be aware that 2013 grant funds will be disbursed only after the 2011 Stormwater Management Program Plan Grant (sixth LB1226 grant) has been closed-out and all previous stormwater grant reporting requirements have been met.**



Submittal of this application constitutes a request for grant funding from the Storm Water Management Plan Program. Requirements of this grant are as follows:

- The Sponsor must provide at least a 20% cash match for any funds received.
- This cash match and the grant award must be kept together in an account separate from any other funds.
- These funds must be used only for implementation of the NPDES Municipal Separate Storm Sewer permit #NER210007.
- These funds may not be used for normal operations and maintenance or flood control.
- The project duration must not go beyond June 30, 2015.
- The Sponsor must provide an annual report, for each grant, due at the end of each state fiscal year.
