RESOLUTION DECLARING 1960 INTERNATIONAL TD9 TRACKCAVATOR
SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-104(6) (Reissue 1997), the County has the power to do all acts in relation to the concerns of the County necessary to the exercise of its corporate powers; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §23-103 (Reissue 1997), the powers of the County as a body are exercised by the County Board; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Board approved a Vehicle Acquisition and Disbursement Policy on January 13, 1998 governing in part the disposal of surplus equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the Sarpy County Landfill's 1960 International TD9 Trackcavator, Unit # L362, has been determined to be obsolete or not usable by the County:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners that the aforementioned Landfill TD9 Trackcavator is hereby declared to be surplus property and authorizes the Purchasing Department to dispose of the equipment in the best interest of Sarpy County.

The above Resolution was approved by a vote of the Sarpy County Board of Commissioners at a public meeting duly held in accordance with applicable law on the 5th day of March, 2013.



Per Sarpy County Resolution "Approving Vehicle Acquisition & Disbursement Policy", January 13, 1998, attached is the Fleet Service recommendation for disposal of Landfill equipment.

It is the recommendation of George Funderburk, Fleet Service, that the Sarpy County Landfill's 1960 International TD9 Trackcavator, Unit # L362, be declared surplus property. Records indicate October 5, 1999 was the last time this equipment was serviced. Any repairs made to the Trackcavator would exceed the equipment's current value. The Trackcavator will not be replaced. It is further recommended that it be sold through publication in heavy equipment publications.
