RESOLUTION MAKING 15 MARCH 2013, LT RUSS ZEEB DAY
IN SARPY COUNTY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, Lt. Russ Zeeb began his distinguished 41 years of public service by enlisting in the United States Army in December 1971, and after two years of military service, Lt. Zeeb was hired by the Sarpy County Sheriff's Office in January 1974; and,

WHEREAS, Lt. Russ Zeeb received countless commendations during his distinguished 39-year career as a deputy sheriff and was equally valued for his other faithful public service to the community that included duties as a volunteer firefighter for the Papillion Fire Department for 40 years, an elected Papillion City Councilman for 12 years, an active member of the Gretna Optimist Club for many years, and most notably as Nebraska Governor Dave Heineman's appointee to the Nebraska Jail Standards Board, an esteemed position he still holds today; and,

WHEREAS, Lt. Russ Zeeb's greatest passion involved his relentless fight to protect our youth, especially from drug and alcohol abuse, and his diligent efforts were evident through his exhaustive work with Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Tobacco Free Sarpy, Gretna Citizens' Committee, and many other community groups; and he worked closely with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety to curb motor vehicle deaths and injuries stemming from alcohol consumption, seat belt violations, and illegal texting; and,

WHEREAS, Sarpy County is also indebted to Lt. Russ Zeeb's family, his wife Shellie and daughter Stephanie, who have supported his career of extensive public service that often took valuable family time away from them; and,


WHEREAS, the service of a law enforcement officer is a profession of the highest calling, honor and sacrifice.
