Jail	Sarpy County houses prisoners on behalf of the State of Nebraska. Effective with the passage of LB 383, Sarpy County no longer receives any reimbursement for the housing of State prisoners. For the first quarter ending 9/30/2010 Sarpy County received a payment of \$97,755, which was based on a rate of \$35/day, which equates to 2,793 prisoner days per quarter or 11,172 prisoner days per year. The true cost of holding a state prisoner as calculated in the County's Indirect Cost Allocation Plan for the 2016 FY is \$134 per day. The 11,172 prisoner days multiplied by a daily rate of \$134 equals an annual cost of \$1,497,048. Please note that total prisoner days for the 2015 FY was 48,214.	\$1,497,048
Sales Tax Commission	A number of years ago the State reduced the commission the County Treasurer is eligible to retain for collecting sales taxes on motor vehicles. The County's sales tax commission loss is estimated at \$107,000. Legislation has been introduced to restore this fee.	\$107,000
Insufficient Fees	Almost all of the fees charged by County offices are set by State Statute. Many of these fees fall short of generating sufficient revenues to cover the cost of providing the required services. A few (not all inclusive) examples are: Service Fees - Writs, Warrants, etc - Sheriff Motor Vehicle Inspection Fees - Sheriff	\$\$\$
Law Enforcement Training Center	For many years, the cost of meals provided to deputies being trained at the Law Enforcement Training Center (LETC) was covered by the State. Several years ago, the decision was made to pass that cost on to the entity sending the deputy for training. The cost came to \$6,486 for the 2017 FY. In addition, because of insufficient State funding for the LETC, there is a significant backlog for recruit training positions. Because of the delay in enrolling recruits at the LETC, Sarpy County and several other jurisdictions have been compelled to start their own Law Enforcement Training Acedemy at County and City expense.	\$6,486
Jail	LB 605 was passed by the Legislature in 2015. This bill changes sentencing guidelines used by the judges and will result in some prisoners being sentenced to County Jail that formerly would have been sentenced to the State Penatentiary. In addition, the bill provides that State probation officers can recommend time in County Jail as a sanction for violation of probation. It is felt that this bill has resulted in an increase in the cost of housing prisoners, although the exact monitary impact is difficult to determine. As a result of LB605, Sarpy County did receive a grant of \$22,000, however, none of these funds can be used to offset the increasing cost of housing prisoners.	\$\$\$
